2. Describe existing conditions on the property:

The existing impermeable surface coverage of the site, before the new development, was 25%. An efficient layout of the new development, approved on June 18, 2019, yielded a 16.7% impermeable surface coverage. In addition, a payment to the Town of Skaneateles Land and development rights Acquisition Fund (DRA) was made since the 10% was not achievable.

3. Describe proposed physical or operational changes to the property:

During construction, some of the proposed impervious features were minimized or eliminated to reduce the impermeable surfaces as much as possible. A current as-built survey (attached) indicates the impermeable surface coverage (without the grass strip removed) at 17.7% vs 16.7% approved.

While the impervious feature reduction does not completely make up the difference in what was previously approved, it is very close at 682 square feet over the approved 10,306 square feet. The overall impermeable area is still significantly lower than the existing condition prior to construction and all other practicable measures have been taken to reduce impermeable surface coverage. The previously approved storm water management system has functioned very well throughout the rain events this year, despite the heavy amount of rain fall.
